



## **Two Downtown Condos Face Class-Action Law Suits Over Falling Balcony Glass**

Residents of two downtown condos have filed a \$30-million (\$15 million each) class action lawsuit after panes of glass fell from their balconies last summer.

The two separate suits against Murano Towers (Bay and College) and Festival Tower (King and John), allege that the developers are responsible for the falling glass. As a result, residents were not able to use their balconies "for months"
